Property Description

1910s detached red-brick house with sash windows, slate roof and many original features

What changes have you made to your home?

Some insulated solid floor (5 inch polystyrene) with wet under-floor heating, some insulated suspended floor;
Most walls internally insulated (2 inch hemp insulation);
New condensing gas boiler;
Wood stove installed;
Draught proofed doors and windows;
Natural materials used, ie cork floor, hemp insulation, eco paints, future recyclability of materials.

Why did you make these changes?

To improve energy efficiency and therefore reduce energy bills, and also improve comfort.

What were the approximate costs?

Work was carried out piecemeal over time, so difficult to assess.

What have been the approximate energy savings?

As above.

Most measures have worked well, need to re-in force older work.
Insulating under suspended floor not as good as hoped for.
Used to be heated with electric storage heaters, not comfortable.
